



## Activity: Family Bushcraft

This a day's bushcraft experience in 44 acres of woodland for families with children of all ages. Bushcraft basics will be demonstrated to encourage families and individuals to take an active part. This activity is all about being in the woods for a day with your family, having fun in the company of like-minded people.

**Venue:** Roundwood, near Brokerswood, Southwick. Meet in the car park.

**Directions:** From the A36 at Standerwick turn off at the Bell Pub and go through Rudge following the yellow signs for Brokerswood Holiday Park. Turn right at the Full Moon Pub and carry on, passing the Mead Nursery. At the crossroads (tin church) straight on for 25 metres, on the right is the gateway into Roundwood.

From Southwick and North Bradley follow the Brokerswood Holiday Park yellow signs, go past the Park entrance then after 100 metres the gateway into Roundwood is on the left (if you get to a crossroads you have gone too far). The car park is just inside the gateway.

**Time:** Start: 10:00. Finish: 15:00.

**Domestics:** Children must be accompanied by an adult. The campsite is undercover but many of the activities are in the open woods. Most woodland paths are uneven and the toilet block, with flushing toilets, is 5 minutes walk away from the camp.

**Clothing:** Long trousers and sensible shoes should be worn, along with a raincoat if necessary.

**Food:** Hot and cold drinks will be supplied. Bring your own food to cook over the campfire but please keep it simple ie sausages and/or burgers with rolls. We supply all cooking pans and utensils, including separate ones for vegetarians.

### Programme:

Below is the outline for the day, but this is flexible and may vary to meet the needs of those taking part. As this is a family activity there will be lots of games for the children included.

1. Meet and greet in Roundwood car park.
2. Woodland walk to Bushcraft camp.
3. Introduction to bushcraft and the day's activities.
4. Shelter building in the woods.
5. Fire lighting.
6. Cook your own lunch over an open fire.
7. How to find and purify water.
8. Whittling.
9. Toasting marshmallows.
